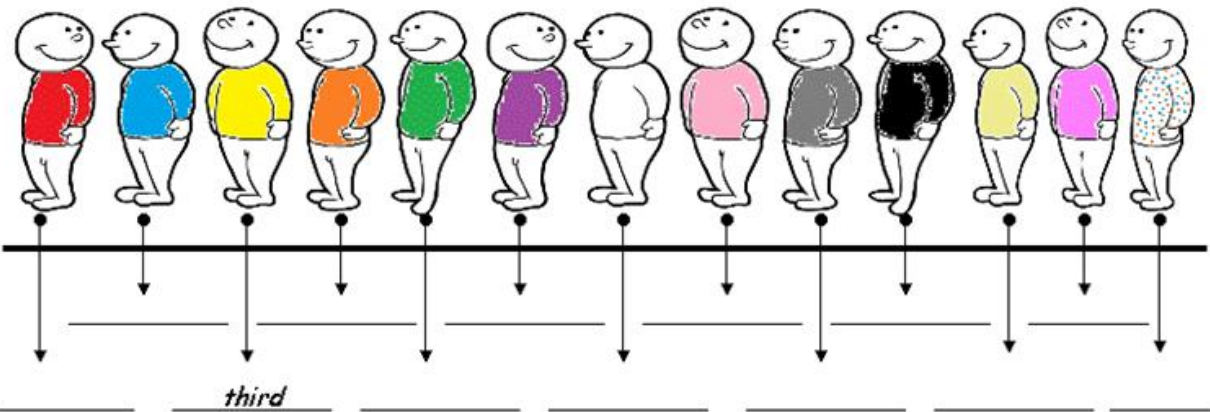

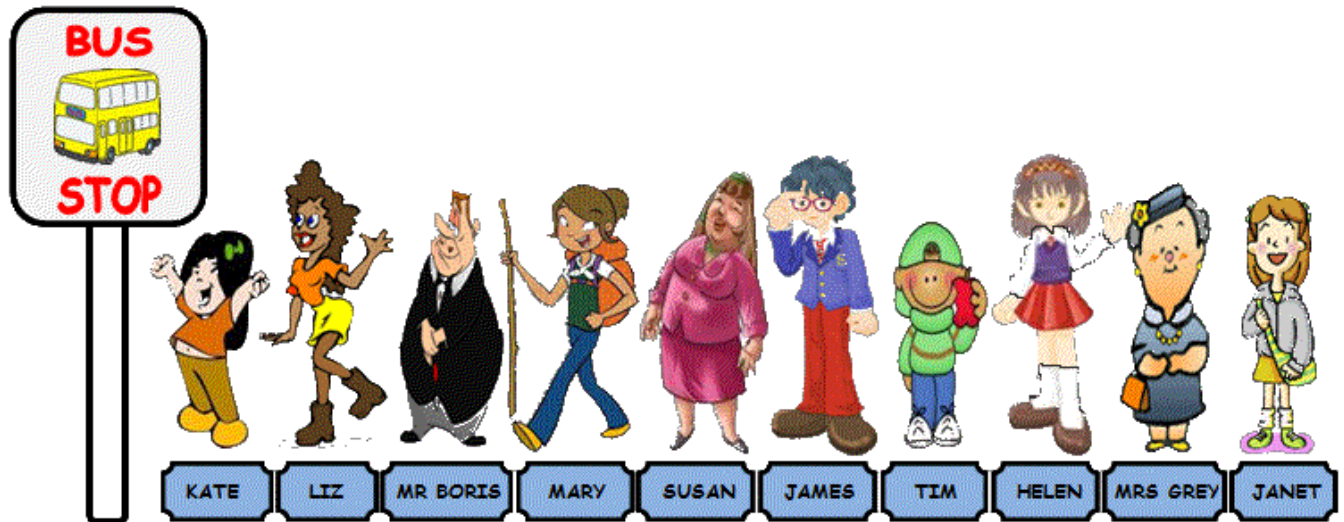

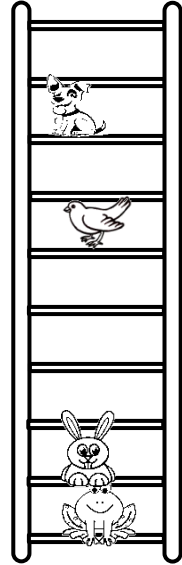

-ch, -sh, -s, -x, -z

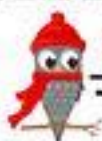
add **-es**
