Remember to follow these steps to know how to conjugate each verb correctly in the simple past:

- 1- Look at the list of irregular verbs to see if that verb is there. If it is not, then it is a regular verb.
- 2- If it ends with an « e », add a « d ».
- 3- If it ends with a consonnant followed by « y », transform the y into « i » and add « ed ».
- 4- If it is any other ending, add « ed ».
