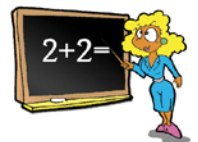

Simple Present Activities

Remember:

Affirmative form : for the 3rd person singular you need to add « s » to the base form of the verb. If the verb ends in *s, sh, ch, x, o or z*, you need to add « es ». If the verb ends with a consonant followed by « y », transform the « y » into « i » and add « es ».

Negative: For the 3rd person singular, you use does not (or doesn't) and the verb is in the base form.

Questions: For the 3rd person singular, use « does » and the verb is in the base form.

For **all other subjects**, the verb stays in the base form for affirmative, use « don't » for negative and « do » for questions.
