- 4- Write sentences to describe the connections you have with different people. Follow the model sentences on page 4. Try to vary your sentences.

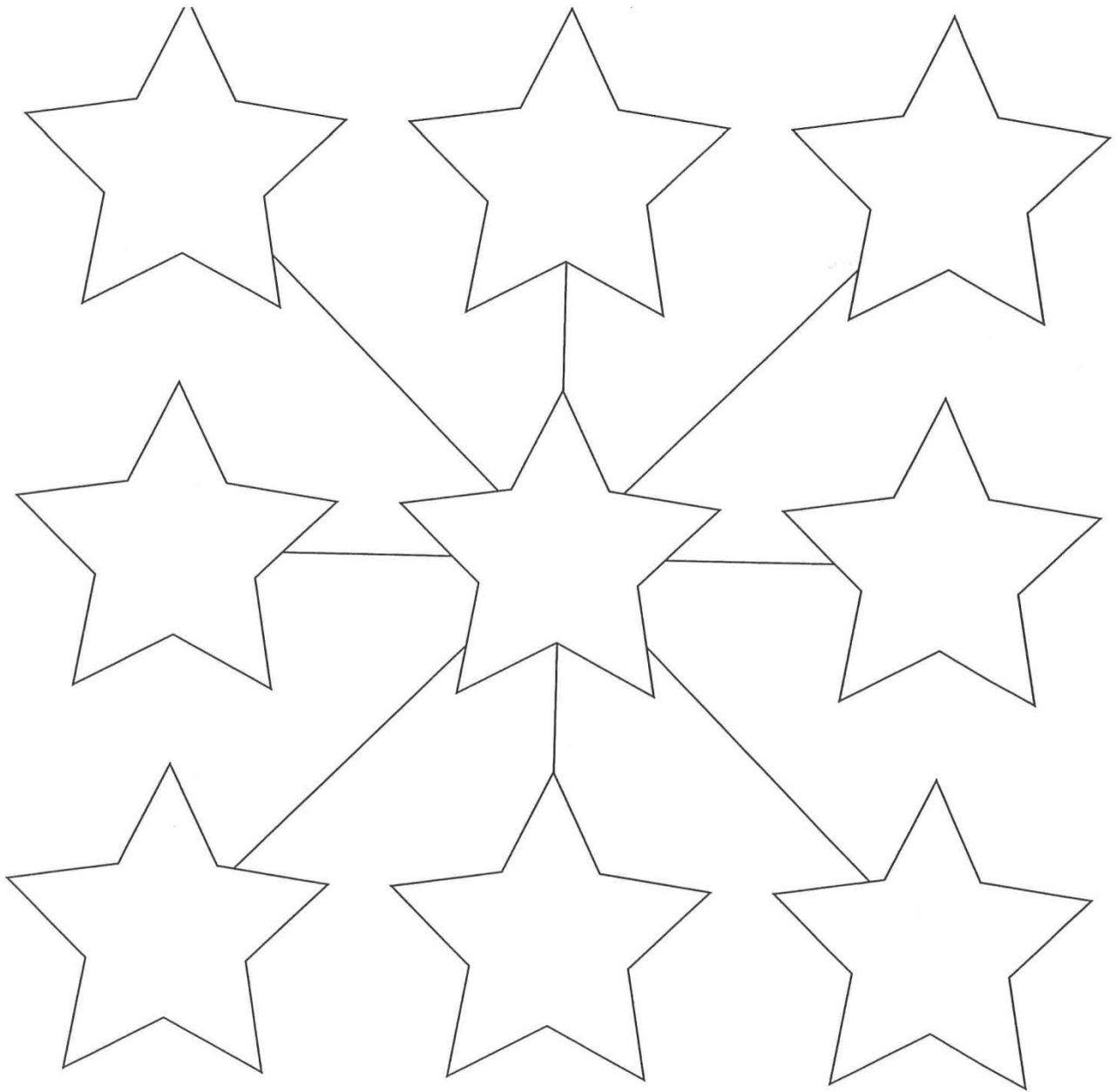
